Main goals

1. To read pictures in a critical way
2. To disrupt the commonplace about homelessness
3. To propose a social action related to the controversial topic of invisible poor people



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Description of this proposal

It is imperative to learn how to read any picture in a critical way, in order to educate critical citizens capable to disrupt the commonplace and make a difference in the world.

Reading is not just decoding words, but also interpreting as a social practice.

In this educative proposal, students will learn to read a picture about a homeless in a rich city (New York), search for it in the online archives, and finally propose a social action related to the problem of the invisibility of poor people in our society.

Methodological aspects

This is a CLIL lesson that includes social studies and visual literacy. It can be used in sixth grade, and also in the first cycle of secondary education.
